This Sunday the Church prepares us to reflect more deeply on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This mystery expresses the very nature of God. Through baptism and faith, we are invited into a closer relationship with God and called to live in love and unity with one another.

As we continue within the season of Ordinary Time, the liturgical colour green reminds us that our faith is meant to keep growing. In the Catholic Church, Ordinary Time is not “ordinary” in the sense of being unimportant, but rather comes from the word ordinal, meaning “counted” or “ordered” time. It is the longest season of the liturgical year, and it is dedicated to the steady growth of the Christian life, following the mysteries of Christ in everyday life. It is a time when the Church invites us to reflect on how we live out our faith day by day, outside the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter.

The colour green symbolises hope, life, and spiritual growth. It reminds us that, just as plants grow steadily and quietly over time, so too our relationship with God deepens through patience, prayer, and daily life. Even during the ordinary moments of our lives, God continues to work in us, helping us grow in hope, patience, and holiness.

Although the Easter season has come to an end, the joy of the Resurrection is still alive. Jesus continues to walk beside us each day, guiding and strengthening us through the Holy Spirit, especially during moments when life feels difficult or uncertain.

On this last Sunday of May, as the Month dedicated to Mary comes to an end, we are reminded that our devotion to Our Lady does not end here. Even as May passes, we must continue to keep her close to our hearts, asking for her guidance and learning from her quiet faith and trust in God.

As we head towards the feast day of The Sacred Heart of Jesus on the 12th of June, Jesus shows us his love in a very personal way. So during this season of Ordinary Time, may we continue to stay rooted in Christ and allow His grace to guide our lives. May the Most Holy Trinity lead us closer to Jesus, and may the Sacred Heart help us share God's love within our families, parish, schools, workplaces, and communities.

May we always remember that the Heart of Jesus remains open to everyone who seeks Him with faith and trust.


