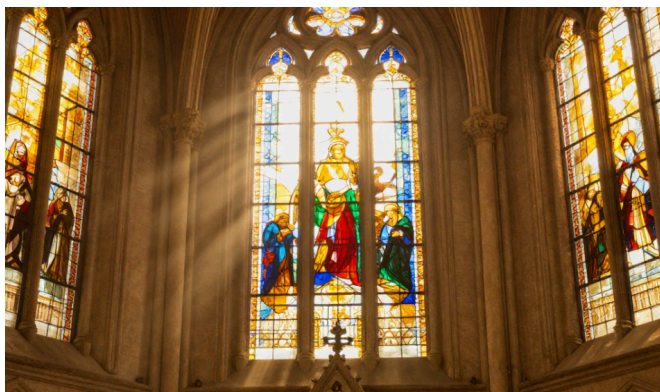

Christ at the Heart of the Liturgy

Sacrosanctum Concilium: Understanding the Sacred Liturgy

The opening chapters of Sacrosanctum Concilium remind us that the liturgy begins not with human initiative but with God's saving love. From the beginning of history, God prepared His people for the coming of His Son. In the fullness of time, Jesus Christ came among us to proclaim the Gospel, heal the brokenhearted, and reconcile humanity with the Father.

The Council teaches that Christ accomplished this work of salvation principally through His Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension—the Paschal Mystery. Through His death He conquered sin and death; through His resurrection He opened for us the way to new life. Every liturgical celebration draws its power from this saving mystery.

When we gather for Mass, we are not simply remembering events that happened long ago. Through the liturgy, Christ's saving work becomes present and effective in our lives today. The Eucharist allows us to share in the fruits of His sacrifice and to receive the grace that flows from His victory over death.

As we reflect on the liturgy, we are invited to see it as God's gift to His people. The Mass is not an obligation to be fulfilled but a privileged encounter with the living Christ who continues to save, heal, and transform us.


