The Second Vatican Council begins its reflection on the Eucharist by taking us back to the Upper Room. There, on the night before He died, Jesus instituted the Eucharist as the perpetual memorial of His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Every celebration of the Mass makes present the one sacrifice of Christ on Calvary—not as a repetition, but as a living participation in the saving mystery of our redemption.

Sacrosanctum Concilium beautifully describes the Eucharist as "a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, and a paschal banquet." In every Mass we encounter the Risen Lord, receive His Body and Blood, and are strengthened to become His Body in the world. The Eucharist is not simply one devotion among many; it is the very heart of the Church's life.

As we gather around the altar each Sunday, we are united not only with one another but also with Catholics throughout the world and with the saints in heaven. Every Eucharist reminds us that we belong to Christ and to one another. The more deeply we enter into this mystery, the more our lives become a living expression of the love we celebrate.

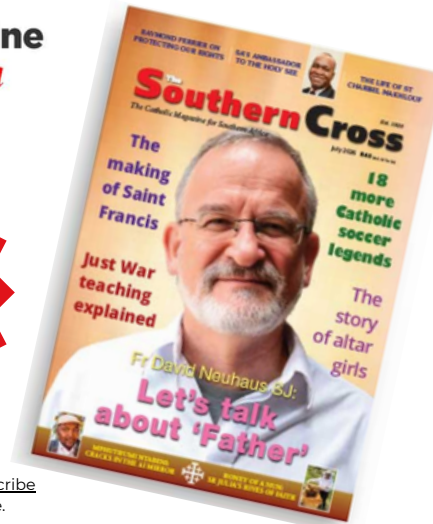
